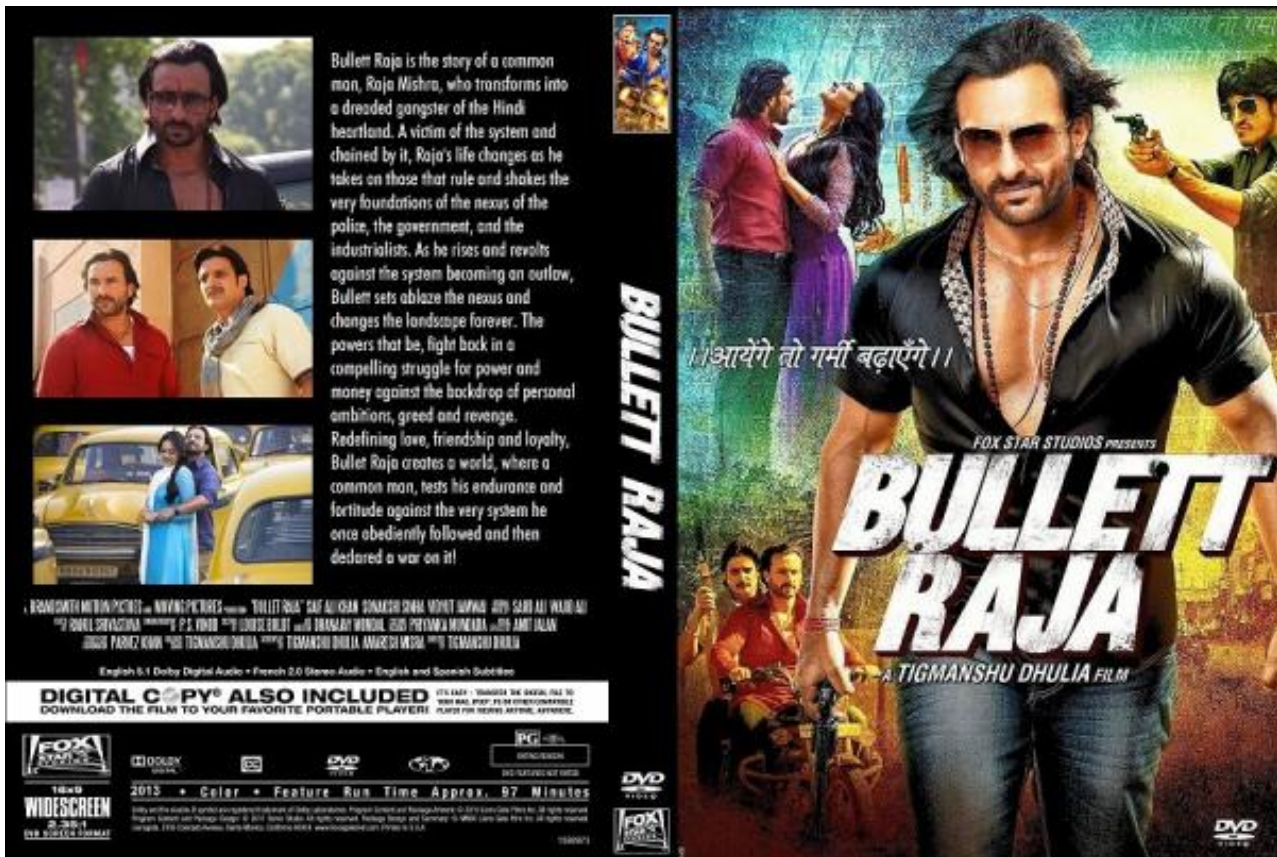

However, a small percentage of children and adolescents with MS may have an early onset disease.

Symptoms of MS in Children The most common symptom of MS in children is a loss of coordination or balance. Vision problems are also common. Other symptoms include: weakness in the legs difficulty with speech or swallowing muscle weakness trouble walking speech problems neck pain Abnormal MRI findings may be seen in children and adolescents. The cerebellum is involved in MS in children as it is in adults. There is a higher risk of relapse in children than in adults. Treatment of MS in Children The treatment of MS in children is similar to the treatment of MS in adults.
